

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN GATHERING GENIUS, INC. (G2) AND
A SCIENCE TEACHER IN THE STATE OF NEVADA**

Whereas, Gathering Genius, Inc. (hereafter G2) is the host organization for May 2009 Intel International Science and Engineering Fair for Reno Nevada;

Whereas, said G2 wishes to increase the numbers of high quality high school science fair projects submitted to regional affiliated ISEF Fairs in the State of Nevada, thence to the Intel ISEF in May 2009;

And whereas, _____ (your name here, hereafter the Intel ISEF Science Fair Coach or simply "coach") is a licensed teacher in the State of Nevada who wishes to assist G2 in this effort;

NOW THEREFORE the undersigned parties do agree as follows:

_____ (Coach name) will:

Establish a program on the campus of _____ (school name) to assist, mentor, and guide high school students for the purposes of submitting a project to the regional science fair affiliated with the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair;

If this school program can be taught as an approved after school class for high school credit, each student participating in the program will be enrolled in the class and receive such credit;

This program may be established during the regular school day, but if so then the Coach stipend of \$2400.00 mentioned below cannot be paid;

The Coach will send monthly e-mail reports of progress and difficulties to co-Chair Paul Buck at paul.buck@nsc.nevada.edu on or about the 15th of each month;

The Coach will spend a minimum of 80 hours working directly with student(s) in the development of their research projects, preferably one or more hours twice each week until the regional fair;

The project must be consistent with the rules and regulation of the Intel ISEF as promulgated in the 2009 ISEF student handbook (<http://www.societyforscience.org/isef/index.asp>);

The project must fall into one of the categories as established in the above mentioned handbook;

The Coach (your name here _____) will ensure that one or more student(s) submit high quality high school science fair projects compliant with Intel ISEF guidelines to their regional fair for judging;

If the project is recommended by the regional fair to go forward to the Intel ISEF competition in Reno, the Coach (your name here _____) will ensure that all necessary forms and paperwork required by the Intel ISEF are completed fully and in a timely fashion as required by the Intel ISEF handbook and other guidelines;

If the student's projects is accepted for the 2009 Intel International Coach will continue working with the student at least 2 hrs per week until May 15, 2009;
